










Markers of Success (Summary)

The Coach is **Present**

COACH



- Coach is **present** responding to the whole of the client and the client's objectives
- Coach is **present** as demonstrated by empathetic observations
- Coach is **present** noticing and exploring the slightest shifts in the client's demeanor
- Coach is **present** as a co-learner in the classroom of the coaching session


- Coach **partners** with the client to determine the direction of the session.
- Coach partners with the client to invite the client to be creative with the coach's inputs
- Coach partners by reflecting the client's language and ideas
- Coach partners by encouraging the client to create their own version of the learning





Broad change of direction?

"This sounds like a pretty significant shift today. What would the person who started the coaching process 3 months ago think?"



Significance of Learning and Action?

Help the **Present Client** reflect on the perspective of the **Future Client**.

"What would the person who has completed the coaching program say to you right now?"
